STOWING TROUT LAKE – Ashford, Kent

With July/August probably being the most challenging months, the most successful flies are Buzzers, Montanas, PTN's, Damsels, Bloodworms, Nymphs and Wet Adams are still tempting the trout to try their luck. The evening rises are at times spectacular but sadly lots of the anglers check out too soon to enjoy the sport! Best fish taken was a five pound plus Rainbow caught on a Hare's Ear by **Nigel Grieve** from Rainham.

BRICK FARM LAKES – Herstmonceux, East Sussex

After a hot, dry and slow July, trout are showing much more activity on the surface. Recent Rainbow catches include a 5lb 2oz by **John Harratt** from St Leonards-on-Sea on a Diawl Bach, 4lb 6oz by **A Smith** from Crowborough on a Black Fritz, 4lb 4oz by **Bob Casey** from Battle on a Minkie, 4lb by **A Steel** from Eastbourne on an Ace of

Spades and a 4lb 6oz by **L Wilson** from Peacehaven on a Buzzer. Also of note promising 11 year old angler **Matthew Bishop** (pictured here) recently caught a beautiful 3lb 2oz Brown Trout on Brick Lake. Despite barely being able to cast he got the line out about 25 feet and started retrieving really slowly when the "Big Brownie" grabbed the fly and then proceeded to give him the fight of a lifetime. What is more remarkable is that the water is never stocked with Brown Trout!

Open every day right through the year from sunrise to sunset, juniors welcome on guardian's ticket.

CHALK SPRINGS – Arundel, West Sussex

Another very good month with just over 100 rods per week, with an average catch rate of around 79%. Rainbows to 11lb, browns to 12lb and blues to 8lb were the best caught this month. During the hot, bright weather small flies have been working best - Hare's Ears, Diawl Bachs, WAEF's and Buzzers being the most popular. Goldhead Damsels, Bloodworms and Daddy Longlegs have also been working well. A few fish have been taken on dries - mainly in the early evening. The water is still nice and cool as it is fed by the springs, and this means the fish continue to feed throughout the day. The fishing should remain consistent in the coming weeks, especially if the weather cools slightly. As always, check the website for full details and pre-booking advised.
